LLANYMYNECH.

COMMITTAL OF A FATHER FOR THE MANSLAUGHTER OF HIS SON.

The adjourned inquest on the body of James Davies, rockman, Llanymynech, was held on Friday, before R. D. Harrison, Esq., coroner, and a respectable jury, when the following evidence was heard:—

Mr J. F. Eyeley, surgeon, said—I made a *post mortem* examination of the deceased on Thursday. I first saw the deceased on Friday, the 16th. I was sent for on the preceding evening, but I was not at home. I found him in bed at his father's house. He was suffering from compression of the brain. He was quite unconscious. I have attended the deceased before. In the *post mortem* examination I found a contused wound at the back of the left ear, about half an inch in diameter, penetrating the skull and the brain. It must have been inflicted by a blow, but from what substance I cannot say. Falling on the edge of a sharp stone, from some distance, may have caused it. I attended him till his death. He never rallied. He died on Monday, the 19th. I am satisfied that he died from the fracture of the skull. When I was making the *post mortem* examination David Davies, the father of deceased, told me that he had a quarrel with deceased, when he threw a bit of delph or dirt at him that hit him on the head, when the deceased fell on his knees and cursed him. I did not put any questions at all to him, neither did I make any reply to him.

Richard Ellis, in addition to the evidence given on the previous Tuesday, said—When I first saw the deceased I took him into the stable. He vomited while in the stable and once again on the road. The deceased did not tell me how he was hurt. I did not ask more than once, and that was on the rock, when he said "ask him," at the same time pointing at his father.

After the house was cleared and a short consultation, the jury returned a verdict that "the deceased was killed by a stone thrown by his father." David Davies was then committed to take his trial at the Montgomeryshire Assizes. Bail was accepted.
