


The addressee is we believe Miss Ivy Astle or Aster. Nurse Reid has authorised the card (for free post) in the bottom left. The postmark is "Field Post Office A.3" which equates to the 3rd Army in France, and the date is 11 Aug 1915. The red triangle is the censor stamp in use at that time. The number in the triangle is 1175. Numbers were allocated to specific units but in this case we were unable to match a user.
