1. Three Main Subscription Websites for England & Wales:

<u>http://www.ancestry.co.uk/</u> - This site contains many records including Census (not 1911yet but coming shortly), GRO Births, Marriages & Deaths, Parish Records, Military Records, Immigration Records MD & Wills & Probate etc. There are 3 subscriptions prices:-

Essentials Membership - Includes all the important records to get you started. Find births, marriages and deaths, access census records and discover military records and more – This costs £49.00 per 6 months, or £9.99 a month. (Oct 2013).

Premium Membership - Access to all Essentials records and also go even further back, beyond official government records which began in 1837. Plus, search Irish record collections, immigration records and new historical record releases. This costs £79.00 per 6 months, or £14.99 a month. (Oct 2013).

Worldwide Membership - Access all Essentials and Premium records plus explore all records on Ancestry worldwide including immigration records for Australia, the US and Canada. Perfect if you have ancestors from overseas. This costs £99.00 per 6 months, or £19.99 a month. (Oct 2013).

http://www.findmypast.co.uk/ - This site contains many records including all available Census Records, GRO Births, Marriages & Deaths, Parish Records, Military Records & Migration Records MD etc. There are 3 subscriptions prices:-

Foundation Subscription - Access to 1911 Census, 1841/1901 Census and GRO Births, Marriages & Deaths. This costs £79.95 a year, or £49.95 for 6mths. (Oct 2013).

Full Subscription - Access to Foundation and Parish Records, Migration Records, Military Records & Specialist Records. This costs £109.95 a year, or £69.95 for 6mths. (Oct 2013).

World Subscription – Access to all records including USA, Australia/New Zealand and Ireland. This costs £159.95 a year, or £99.95 for 6mths. (Oct 2013).

Starter – Access to Census (not 1911yet but coming shortly), GRO Births, Marriages & Deaths. This costs £54.95 a year, or £28.95 for 6mths. (Oct 2013).

Gold – Access to starter plus Wills & Probates, Some Parish Records, Some Military Records & Some Electoral/Poll Records. This costs £68.95 a year, or £44.95 for 6mths. (Oct 2013).

Diamond – Access to Starter & Gold, plus all Parish Records, all Military Records, all Electoral/Poll Records & Specialist Records. This costs £109.95 a year (Aug 2013).
