

LLANFYLLIN,

HIRNANT, LLANFECHAN, LLANFIHANGEL, LLANGYNOG, LLANRHAIAADR-YN-MOCHNANT, LLAN-SAINFFRAID, MEIFOD, PENNANT, PENYBONTVAWR, PENYGARNEDD, AND NEIGHBOURHOODS.

LLANFYLLIN is an ancient market town, in the parish, hundred, poor law union, and county court district of its name, county of Montgomery, 180 miles n.w. from London, 36 n.e. from Machynlleth, 21 s. from Corwen, 20 s.e. from Bala, 11 n.n.w. by road and 17 by rail from Welshpool, and 14 s.w. from Oswestry (Salop), seated in the midst of a beautiful and fertile valley, almost surrounded by hills. The town consists principally of one street, through which the high road from Shrewsbury to Bala passes. It is watered by two streams, the Abel and the Cain, which give motion to several corn mills. The town was incorporated by Llewellyn ap Gruffyd in the reign of Edward I. and its government invested in a high steward, recorder, two bailiffs (who are justices of the peace for the borough), and fifteen capital burgesses, out of which two bailiffs are elected annually by the Free Burgesses. A court baron is held by the lord of the manor annually. Llanfyllin shares with Montgomery and other places named in the description of that town in returning one member to Parliament, and it is included in the twenty-ninth circuit of towns under the County Court Acts for the recovery of debts to any amount not exceeding £50. Borough petty sessions are held here on the first and last Tuesday in each month, and county petty sessions on the first Friday in each month, except October.

The places for divine worship are the parish church of St. Myllin, and chapels for Baptists, Independents, Calvinists, and Wesleyan Methodists. The living of Llanfyllin is a rectory, value £650 annually, in the patronage of the Bishop of St. Asaph. A Mrs. Vaughan founded a charity school for 24 poor children, which is now conducted on the National plan; there is also one on the British plan. A branch of the Cambrian railway now runs to this town from Llanymynech. The market is held on Thursday and the fairs the last Thursday in each month; wool fair, July 9th.

HIRNANT is a parish in the poor law union and county court district of Llanfyllin, and 6 miles w.n.w. therefrom. The living of the parish is a rectory, in the gift of the Bishop of St. Asaph.

LLANFECHAN is a small village and parish, about 4 miles e. from Llanfyllin, and in that union and county court district, situated on the road from Llanfyllin to Llan-saintffraid. The parish church is dedicated to St. Garmon; the living is a rectory, in the gift of the Bishop of St. Asaph; there is also a place of worship for Calvinistic Methodists, and a National school.

LLANFIHANGEL, OR LLANFIHANGEL-YN-GWYNVA is a parish

6 miles s. from and in the county court district and union of Llanfyllin. The church is dedicated to Saint Michael; the living is a rectory in the same patronage as Llanfechan; there is also a chapel of ease at Llwydiarth.

LLANGYNOG parish, with a straggling village, is in the union and county court district of Llanfyllin, and about 8 miles n.w. therefrom. Large quantities of slate are obtainable from the quarries in this parish, but owing to the inconvenience of transit they cannot be worked as profitably as they otherwise might be. The parish church is dedicated to St. Cynog; the living, a rectory, is in the patronage of the Bishop of St. Asaph. A fair is held on 14th September.

LLANRHAIAADR is a small village in the parish of LLANRHAIAADR-YN-MOCHNANT, counties of Denbigh and Montgomery, about six miles n. from Llanfyllin, and in the union and county court district of the latter. About 4 miles from the village is a beautiful waterfall called Pistyll Rhaiadr, which has a perpendicular fall of 72 feet. The parish church is dedicated to St. Dogvan; the living, a vicarage, is in the gift of the Bishop of the diocese. There are also chapels for Baptists, Calvinistic and Wesleyan Methodists, and Independents; also a National school.

LLANSAINTFFRAID is a straggling village in the parish of its name, about 6 miles e. from Llanfyllin, and in that poor law union and county court district. It is partly in the hundred of Pool and partly in that of Deythur, and is situated on the road to Oswestry. There is a parish church, the living of which is a vicarage, in the patronage of the Bishop of St. Asaph. There are several chapels for Dissenters; also a National school.

MEIFOD, OR MYFON, is a parish in the hundred of Llanfyllin, Pool and Deythur. It is in the county court district and union of Llanfyllin. This is an ancient place, and by some thought to be the Roman *Mediolanum*. The church, which is partly of Norman architecture, was formerly the burial place of the Princes of Powys, and contains some old tombs. It is dedicated to St. Tysilio, and the living is a vicarage in the gift of the Bishop of St. Asaph. There is also a chapel of ease at Bwlchcibau. Fairs are held the last Friday in each month for pigs, sheep and cattle.

PENNANT, OR PENNANT-MELANGELL, is a parish, situated about 8 miles n.w. from Llanfyllin, in the union and county court district of the latter place. The district around is of a wild and mountainous description. The parish church is dedicated to St. Monocella; the living, a vicarage, is in the gift of the Bishop of St. Asaph.
